Stacy Paetz is a unique mix of Polynesian and Cherokee Indian descent. She's an award winning Television and Podcast Host, Sideline Reporter, Voice Over Specialist and Executive Producer with proven credibility and trust throughout the entertainment and sports industries.

Stacy began her career making history. At only 19-years-old, she made her first on-air appearance on ESPN. She became the first female and youngest individual in the NBA to report from the sidelines as well as host every Indiana Pacers pre-game, halftime, and post-game show at home and on the road for FOX Sports, spanning seven seasons. Stacy was the first female announcer in the 90-year history of the World Famous Harlem Globetrotters announcing on both U.S. and International tours for two seasons. She joined CBS Sports in 2018, as the featured reporter for the inaugural Major League Rugby season, including hosting Trophy and MVP ceremonies. Stacy became the first network Podcast Host and Executive Producer in the WNBA for Bleav Podcast Network, as well as the first host for the National Women's Soccer League on Amazon Prime Video. In 2022, she became the first host for Women's Softball at the World Games. Stacy is Studio Host for Major League Rugby pre-game and halftime shows on CBS and Fox Sports, as well as Host and Producer of MLR All Access, the league's flagship show.

Away from television, Stacy loves adventures. From rock climbing in Alaska to zip lining in San Juan, to floating in the Dead Sea. An Indiana native, Stacy drove an Indy Car three laps around the famed Indianapolis Motor Speedway at 180mph and was "disappointed they put a governor on the car limiting her speed." She rides motorcycles and flies sport planes in pursuit of her private pilot certificate. She's a published author, women's sport apparel designer and documentary filmmaker. Stacy loves giving back to the community with charity and volunteer work.
